Role Play was carried out one-to-one (individual role play) by the Nursery and Jr.KG Classes.







Students took on assigned roles and acted out those roles through scripted dialogues.







Role Play helps in the development of communication and language skills.











Role Playing helps to build creativity and imagination in children.







The Sr.KG class enacted a group role play with each student in the group taking on a role/ character.







Students act out and try to make sense of real life situations. They learn empathy and understand different perspectives.







Role Play is a form of experiential learning (Russell & Shepherd, 2010)
