



ENTERING IN THE DECIMAL ARENA!



The learners of Grade 5, were asked to create the largest and smallest decimal numbers possible with a different set of cards. The class was divided into groups, each group drew 6 cards from the deck: 3 for the whole number part (hundreds, tens, and units) and 3 for the decimal part (tenths, hundredths and thousandths). The groups then filled in their place value charts with their chosen numbers. This activity helped students understand decimal place values and also encouraged teamwork and interactive learning!
